INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FORMAT OF A PERSONAL VIEW PAPER

Personal View articles address a topic in the area of medical/healthcare professions education that is likely to be of interest to Medical Teacher readers. They present and reflect the author's personal experience or viewpoint relating to the topic. For example, an article could relate to implementing a new curriculum, an encounter with students, or personal learning. Such articles may highlight an aspect of the subject often ignored or neglected, and may present a provocative stance which argues against what may be seen as the established or consensus viewpoint.

Articles should be between 750-1500 words, and be written in the first person. They need not be referenced, but a maximum of 5 references may be included if desired. There should be no summary or headings.
